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



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

A Reel Good Reel

Reels are short, portrait-format videos up to 90 seconds on Instagram, similar to TikTok videos.

Across the several formats that Reels can take, they comprise video footage and static images timed to audio (more on this later!)




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Sounds And Trends

Editing Your Reel

ACTIVITY: Make a Reel!

- 1. Swipe right from the feed and select 'Reel'.
 - 2. Select an audio from either your Saved audios or pick a new one.
 - 3. Click on the bottom left Pictures icon to select your footage (tip: Press the "Select Multiple" icon before you begin picking!)
 - 4. Add your clips individually and trim them if desired. (tip: Trim them so they match up with the audio's beats.)
 - 5. Add transitions by navigating to Edit Clips > Transitions > Select the + icon
 - 6. Add text, stickers and filters for a finishing touch voila!


